### ☐ Eligibility

- Applicants must be able to apply for a D-4 visa and enroll for 6 months.
  - \* Please contact the Embassy of the Republic of Korea for visa requirements and necessary documents.

### ☐ Required Documents

- Application form \*with photo attached
- Recommendation letter from the head of the institution or international office at your home univ. \*Free format
- High school graduation certificate \*with consular authorization or apostille
- Bank balance certificate (minimum balance: 8,000,000 KRW; applicant's own account is acceptable)
  - \* If the account is under a parent's name, additional documents are required: parent's employment/income certificate and a family relationship certificate
- Copy of the applicant's valid passport
  - \*\*Original copies of the above documents must be submitted when applying for the D-4 visa.
